## Tip of the Month

### Flag Etiquette:

Never allow the flag to touch the ground or any other object when on display.

Salute the flag as it is hoisted and lowered, during the playing of the National Anthem and while saying the Pledged of Allegiance. Stand at attention with your right hand over your heart and your hat removed.

Display the flag outdoors only between sunrise and sunset, unless illuminated by a spotlight.

When displaying the flag indoors, always position it to the right of a speaker or staging area.

To place a flag at half-staff, hoist it to the peak for an instance before lowering it to a halfway position.

## Trivia Answer

The answer is C. The white line of the hoof is between the outside hoof wall and where it meets the sole, and is the area that looks whitish.
