#### General Membership Meeting Minutes

The January 14, 2017 meeting was called to order by Trudy Bickford @ 7:35 p.m.

Guests Introduction / New Members: No Report

**Secretary's Report:** Posted in the December Hoofbeats, motion to accept as posted by Nancy, seconded by Cathy and passed

**Treasurer's Report:** Copies of report passed out to general membership for review, read & accepted.

**Board of Director's Report:** BOD meeting was held on 1/14/17 @ clubhouse at 6:40 p.m. meeting minutes were read to general membership.

**Trail Report:** Sandy will check Holy Trinity to see if we could hold the awards banquet at that location on 2/18/ or 2/25 and Nancy will reach out to the Litchfield Sportsman's Club, then we will discuss our options.

**Show:** A horse show meeting was scheduled to be held 2/4/17 @ 1:00 p.m. during the down time at the scrap booking fundraiser that is being held at Holy Trinity Church in Lisbon Falls.

**Publicity Report:** Sally has written an article for the Horses Mane. She would also like to include some photos with the article however; the Horses Mane will not publish any photos with riders that are not wearing a riding helmet.

**Building and Land:** Julie mentioned that there is a lot of clean-up that will need to be done this spring due to the recent storms we have had.

Fund Raising: The scrapbooking fund raiser will be held at Holy Trinity Church the St. Cyril Church on Frost Hill Avenue, Lisbon Falls on 2/4/17. Volunteers are needed. Sally was wondering what other type of fund raising we can do. She also inquired what the total cost of the ribbons were for our 3 shows in 2016. Cathy stated that total cost was \$970. Missy discussed a possible idea of handing out slip ribbons at our spring & fall fun shows to Pewees and Juniors only and no ribbons to Seniors. Cathy stated that she felt that we should leave the ribbons as is for the Topsham Fair Show. Sally stated that we really need to be more cautious with the spending of our funds so that we can enjoy more riding time versus fund raising all the time. Cathy stated that she reviewed the 2011 to 2016 membership numbers and we the 2016 number were ½ of the 2011 numbers. 

Sally then stated that we really need to do a close review of what our best fund

raisers are and where are volunteers time would be best served.

Entertainment Committee Report: Missy mentioned the possible summer concert. She will reach out to Courtney to see if she has any new information and Sandy will check with the insurance company to see how this concert would affect our insurance cost.

**Correspondence Report:** Cathy received a letter from the SPCA thanking us for our recent donation. 


