HORSE SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read all regulations and entry information carefully. Exhibitors must be prepared to comply with these rules and regulations. If you have any questions, please contact the Show Managers.

1. Fun show, casual attire accepted. Boots with a heel required, hard hats recommended for children.
2. A 5 second penalty for knocking over a barrel or pole.
3. Age requirement will be effective as of January 1st. Minimum age is 3 years old.
4. A horse or pony will be ridden only once in each class.
5. Any class changes must be made 2 classes in advance.
6. Registration starts at 8:00 a.m. No registrations, other than mailed, will be accepted prior to 8:00 a.m.
7. Dogs must be kept on a leash or tied; fire and emergency lanes must be kept open at all times.
8. You must put a red ribbon in horse's or pony's tail if they kick.
9. Any horse/pony/exhibitor may be disqualified at the discretion of the head of the show committee, with an explanation to the exhibitor.
10. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of owner, rider, exhibitor, or groom, will disqualify the horse from being judged. The management reserves the right to remove any of the previously mentioned without being liable for compensation of damages.
11. Show manager's decisions will be final in all classes.
12. The ring will be available during break for warm up. (No galloping or running.)
13. A hold on a class will be no longer than 2 minutes. Only one hold per class.
14. Food will be available on the grounds.
15. NO REFUNDS without a vet certificate.
16. No Parking on the dirt road entering the grounds.
