

MTRA SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No one may approach the judge without permission from the ring master/ring mistress.
2. Judge's decision is final.
3. Any horse, pony, or exhibitor may be disqualified at the judge's discretion with an explanation to follow.
4. Any horse deemed out of control by the judge or Show committee will be excused with no questions asked.
5. If your horse or pony kicks a red ribbon in their tail is required
6. Any horse deemed lame by judge or Show committee will be excused with no questions asked.
7. Any discourteous or disobedient acts to any official on the part of the owner, rider, exhibitor, or groom will disqualify the horse from being judged. The Show managers reserve the right to remove any of the previously mentioned without being liable for compensation of damages.
8. If either show committee member or judge is concerned that an animal is being abused, they will be asked to leave the grounds immediately.
9. A horse or pony may only be ridden once in each class.
10. Rider May Not Show in More than 2 Over Fences Classes
11. Exhibitors and/or riders must be the age of three (3) as of January 1st.
12. **ANY Rider Under 18 MUST wear ASTM/SEI Helmets At ALL Times When On A Horse/Pony**
13. walk/trot must stay in walk/trot classes and only walk/trot during gaming classes.
14. Lead-liners must continue to be ON LEAD at ALL TIMES. (Leader Must Be over 16 yrs Old)
15. No Cantering Outside of the Ring or Warm-Up Area
16. Proper attire is required for all classes. Western jeans, shirt, boots and hats are required for all gaming classes. Judge or Show manager will determine if dress is appropriate and the decision will be final.
17. One "hold" may be placed on a class with a time limit not to exceed two minutes. There will be no entry into the ring once the judge has closed the class.
18. Any class changes must be made three (3) classes in advance.
19. If there is a fall of horse or rider the combination will be eliminated.
20. A five second (5 second) penalty is given during gaming classes for knockdowns.
21. No refunds without a vet certificate.
22. Fire and emergency lanes must be kept open at all times.
